The International **Doctorate of Business Administration (DBA)** is the **University of Bordeaux's**, French University Degree program (DU) designed for professionals and executives. The program integrates *theory* and ***practice*** of actual business issues allowing participants to be proficient in applied research, so they can make sound managerial and business decisions.

This **DBA Degree** allows Doctorate students to use their high level skills while keeping their career and family's life to do an active doctoral research.. Participants who successfully complete the **DBA** will be equipped to work in numerous sectors including advanced and progressive business knowledge from the prestigious **University of Bordeaux**.

While DBA is open to all areas of business and management, candidates who work in the healthcare sector, have the opportunity via the ASAP and the IIE - PB UNESCO - University of Paris to have complementary and optional series of modules in Healthcare Management, with a certificate issued separately.

Connecting people, knowledge and ideas

The Doctor Degree Program has the capacity to bring the participants to an advanced and up to date knowledge in the **Management** field. The program is *in synch* with today's people needs to learn and exchange in a dynamic global environment.

It will trigger everyone's capacity to participate in high level discussions in group projects and create an impact on everyone who wishes to be differentiated. Due to the fact that these programs occurs in a multicultural environment combined with high quality of teaching, students can have access to a truly unique experience.



Creating highly advanced knowledge

During the DBA you are trained not in solving typical managerial problems (this is often taught in a MBA) but learning methodological tools usage and how to generate advanced knowledge either to solve problems or to understand the reasons of a particular business phenomenon. Instead of having easy or «ready made» answers to business and managerial problems, one learns how to investigate a situation and see, for example, if the application of a certain rule or scenario is able to change or solve an issue. So, in a MBA/Masters, professors share their knowledge with you, but in a Professional Business Doctorate Program, you build up knowledge along with them. The Doctoral Professors and Supervisors are present to help on guidance and methodological consistency.

Coming to the the **Health Care Sector**, you find an opportunity to be an «actor» of creating knowledge or in short: you generate new knowledge. One of the biggest advantages of doing a DBA at the University of Bordeaux is that you can be exploring up-to-date subjects related to your professional areas understanding how best overcome challenges and promoting Innovative practices. The objective here is not to make you through the DBA program to transform or change the World, but rather to impact your own environment.

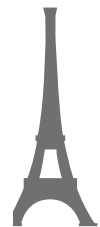

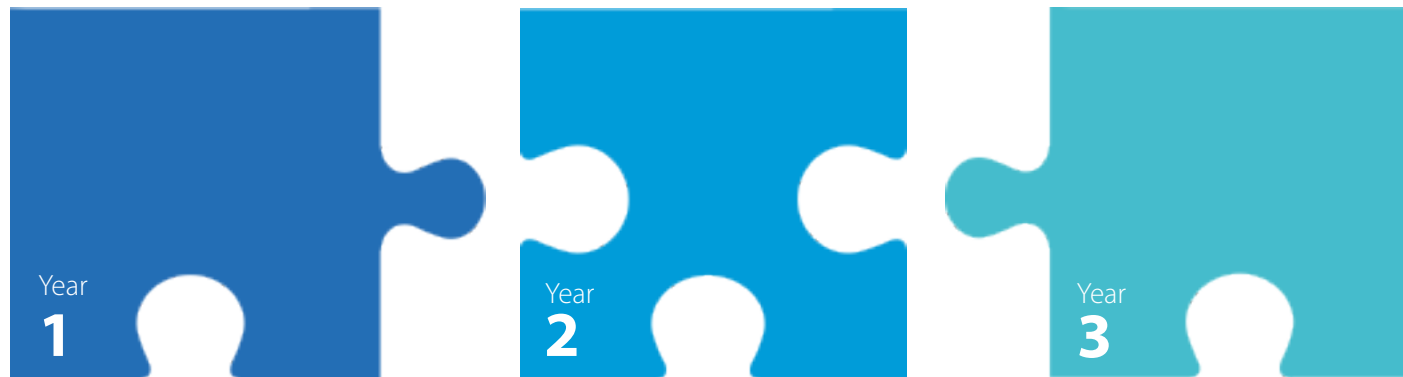

DBA Thesis Process



Defining Topic

Defining a topic for Doctoral dissertation that addresses an issue, concept, or problem to be researched.

Then, once defined, the Doctorate student will describe the design of the research.

Thesis Development

Upon the thesis' research proposal approval, the doctoral student is conducted to the second year, which is dedicated to the research development.

Thesis Presentation

After writing the conceptual framework and conducting the research, it is time to submit the thesis and present it to a board of professors.

Who will I learn from?

DBA Faculty - International DBA Faculty members are highly experienced professionals and engaged in rigorous academic researches on a wide range of business subjects. They also come from an international professional field to share their experiences as well their theoretical knowledge.

You are encouraged to ask questions so the lectures can be highly interactive. You will also be recommended prior and further readings to consolidate your learning. The program will require you to participate in collaborative learning environment.

DBA Tutoring - Following the 1st year, during the 2nd and 3rd year, each Doctorate student will have a tutor who will be guiding and assisting during the thesis process until the defense.

DBA Coordination - In addition to the DBA's individual tutoring, the Doctoral students will also have the support from the Program Coordinators who have an extensive international experience and who are available throughout the entire program duration.

Seminar 1: Health Systems as Social Protection and Employer Responsibility

This module examines healthcare models, financing structures, coverage schemes, and regulatory frameworks, focusing on how responsibility for health is distributed among the State, companies, insurers, and individuals. The guiding question – how different countries allocate responsibility for health – frames a comparison between the Brazilian model and international experiences.

Seminar 2: Corporate Health as Business Strategy

This module marks a paradigm shift from wellness/quality-of-life programs to health management as a strategic architecture within the organization. Topics include diagnostics, priority-setting, governance, key indicators, population health management, and international case studies.

Seminar 3: Psychosocial Risks, Mental Health, and Work Organization

This module builds a technical, balanced, evidence-based debate on where corporate responsibility ends and social/individual factors begin, examining the impact of organizational design, Brazil's NR-1 regulation, and psychosocial risk factors on employee wellbeing.

Seminar 4: Data, Artificial Intelligence, and Digital Health

Covering analytics, key performance indicators, AI applications, and digital health tools, this module addresses how data can support better decision-making without turning corporate health programs into a mechanism for employee surveillance. Technology is framed strictly as a means, never an end in itself.

Seminar 5: Organizational Culture, Leadership, and Sustainable Performance

This module aims to position health as a core component of organizational culture and management models. Discussions cover leadership, culture, governance, sustainability, and the integration of health into overall business strategy.





Bordeaux

Where can I stay?

There are a few options for housing while doing the immersion at Bordeaux.

There are 3 hotels with a 3 minutes walk from the University which is very convenient for 1-2 week stays.

Also there are plenty of Airbnb options online.

Finally students can have access to a brand new Student Residence called Artémisia. The residence is near the University of Bordeaux business school, just 7 min walk, close to supermarket and tramway. Students can stay in a 19m² apartment with all the amenities and comfort, including wifi for a costs around €595 for a month. This is key as for rating students' housing or studios in France, in addition to the month's cost, there is usually a heavy application bureaucracy, security deposit, additional fees etc. This is pretty straightforward. A final and important advantage is the tramway which goes from the Airport to the Artemisia and fare costs around €2.
